## **City of Industry Approves Support for Sheriff's Youth Activities League Golf Tournament** *Annual Golf Tournament to Benefit At-Risk Youth and YAL Programming*

City of Industry, CA – At their last City Council meeting, the City of Industry City Council approved a \$5,000 contribution to the Industry Sheriff's Youth Activities League (YAL) for their 25<sup>th</sup> Annual Invitational Golf Tournament. The tournament, which is being held on May 1<sup>st</sup>, is the largest annual fundraising opportunity for the YAL, to continue their programming for at-risk youth.

"The YAL is a key organization in our community," said Mayor Mark Radecki. "I am proud that our City is able to support them again this year in order to support their continued programs that are critical for our youth and our communities."

The YAL started in 1991 as a collaborative effort between local cities and businesses to counteract the negative forces of gangs and drugs. In addition to providing programs to positively influence at-risk youth, the Sheriff's Youth Activities League also serves over 2,500 local youth through programs such as football, baseball, basketball, scuba, martial arts, summer camps, educational field trips, professional sports events and Sheriff's Explorer Post.

"I'm incredibly grateful for the City's ongoing support of this event and of the YAL in general," said Industry Station Sheriffs Captain Timothy K. Murakami. "Their contributions are key to sustaining the funding necessary to do the great work we do with you here locally."
