**LETTER REPORT
ENVIRONMENTAL AUDIT SUMMARY
EDNA INCORPORATED PROPERTY

Dear Mrs. Dooley:

As per your request during our phone conversation on October 31, 1988, this letter summarizes activities involved in the disposal of all hazardous materials associated with the removal of four underground fuel storage tanks and one dispenser island at the site. Listed below in chronological order are all events completed.

April 8, 1988 - removal of four underground fuel storage tanks and associated fuel dispenser island. Soil sample results indicated contamination of soil present beneath two of the underground tanks and dispenser island.

May 31 and June 1, 1988 - a drill program is undertaken to define the vertical, lateral and concentrations of hydrocarbons present in soil. Results of the drilling and testing program indicate the extent of contamination to be limited to the immediate vicinity of the exhaustion.

June 9, 1988 - approximately 90 cubic yards of hydrocarbon contaminated soil was excavated from the underground storage tank pit area and transported to the southeast portion of the site for atmospheric aeration. Results of efforts to treat the soil by aeration proved unsuccessful due to time constraints and exceptionally high concentration of soil contamination.

October 19, 1988 - loading, transport and proper disposal of all material which could possibly be considered hazardous; a total of 135 tons was transported to Petroleum Wasted Incorporated, located in Taft, California for disposal.

Based on the activities summarized above WES concludes that no further work shall be required and all material associated with the underground fuel tanks which could possible be considered hazardous has been successfully removed from the site.
