**Agreement for Conditions Requested
for Site Access at Somitex Prints
for Soil-Gas Survey**

We have received EMCON Associate's (EMCON) response to our request for access to Somitex Prints of California (Somitex) to perform a soil-gas survey. We agree to meet the conditions set forth by EMCON in their letter of June 13, 1991 as discussed below:

- If possible, soil-gas probes will be driven in the dirt area between the fence and the curb and the drainage gutter to minimize damage to Somitex's property.
- Somitex and EMCON will receive copies of Harding Lawson Associate's final report detailing the results of the soil-gas survey conducted for Utility Trailer Manufacturing Company. Optimal Technology, Incorporated will not generate a report but will supply data that will be included in the HLA report.
- If requested by Somitex, an EMCON staff geologist may be present during the performance of the soil-gas survey that is performed on Somitex's property.
