Dear Mr. Salas:

This letter will serve to memorialize my telephone conversation today with you and Mr. John Lewis of RWQCB.

Harding Lawson Associates [HLA] sent Mr. Lewis a *Soil Stockpile Treatment, Sampling, and Reuse Plan* [November 2, 1995] for his review and comments. I received a call this afternoon from Mr. Lewis regarding the same. He informed me that you were in his office on the speaker-phone. Mr. Lewis agreed with HLA's proposal to reuse all soil in the stockpile except soil represented by samples SP-2 and SP-10. Mr. Lewis suggested that UTM isolate this soil and place it back in the soil treatment area for additional vapor extraction.

Because nearly 3½ months have elapsed since analysis of the samples reported on in the November 2, 1995 letter, HLA has recommended resampling the soil represented by samples SP-2 and SP-10 before conducting any further treatment. If resampling shows concentrations have decreased, we may request RWQCB review of the analytical results, and request to reuse the soil without further treatment.
