We are in receipt of the "Interim Remedial Action Plan - Soil Vapor Extraction (IRAP)," dated July 21, 1994, prepared by your consultant, Harding Lawson Associates, presenting the objectives, technical approach, remedial action, and proposed implementation schedule for the remediation of VOC-impacted soils at the site. This submission is in general compliance with our letter dated April 8, 1994, and the discussions during two meetings between the consultant, yourself, and Board staff on November 15, 1993 and June 29, 1994. Upon review of the IRAP, we have no objections to its implementation.

As a reminder, Board staff require the submission of **three** copies of periodic progress reports, which summarize field activities, remediation conditions, key operational parameters, and mass removal rates. In addition, upon completion of the proposed remedial action and confirmation sampling, a final closure report must be submitted to the Board containing a detailed description of remediation activities and confirmation data.

Based on the tentative implementation schedule included in the IRAP, vapor extraction well installation will commence within seven weeks, or on September 26, 1994, and system startup will occur in thirteen weeks, or on November 14, 1994. Please inform Board staff of any changes in this scheduling. Board staff must be notified at least 72 hours prior to field work at the subject site.
