## **Industry City Council Approves to Explore Management of Open Space and Recreation Space in Tres Hermanos with Los Angeles County Parks and Recreation**

City of Industry, CA – At its September 28 meeting, the Industry City Council unanimously approved an important action item directing City Manager Paul Philips to begin discussions with the Los Angeles County Parks and Recreation about the possibility of having the County Department take over the operations and management of open space and recreation space at Tres Hermanos Ranch.

“We are looking forward to our initial discussions with the County to learn about its possible management and operations of the open and recreational space at Tres Hermanos,” said Philips.

The Oversight Board of The Successor Agency to the Industry-Urban Development Agency approved the City of Industry’s proposal to purchase the 2,450 acres of property located near the 57-60 interchange known as the Tres Hermanos on August 24. Currently the state is reviewing the proposal for final approval. The City has been committed to using the land as open and recreation space and for other public purposes.

The property, originally purchased by the City of Industry, was transferred to its former redevelopment agency in the late 1970s. The City has maintained the property to ensure there is no overgrowth over the years.
