



CITY OF INDUSTRY ECONOMIC IMPACT

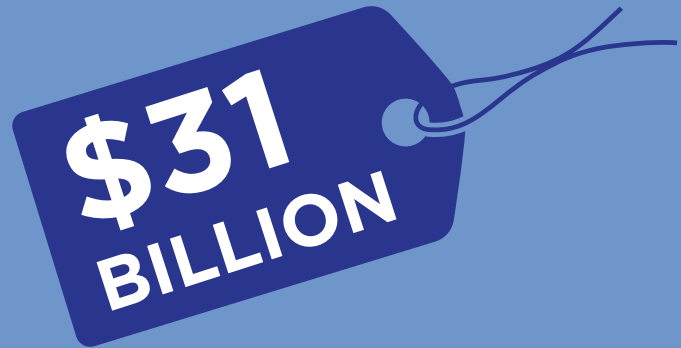
The City of Industry is an economic hub of the San Gabriel Valley. Its contributions to the greater Los Angeles County region help attract business, create jobs and boost the local economy. A 2017 economic study by Emerson Consulting Group was conducted to determine the City's full economic impact in Los Angeles County.

Businesses



3,000

There are approximately 3,000 businesses in the City of Industry



These businesses generate \$31 billion in sales

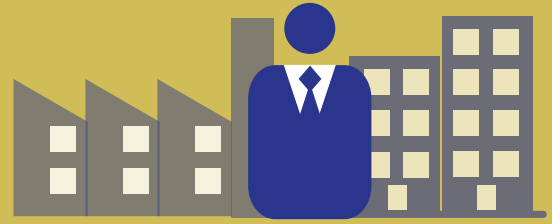
- Of those sales dollars, 11 percent comes from Retail Trade, 63 percent comes from Wholesale Trade, and 12 percent comes from Manufacturing.
- The City of Industry's Wholesale Trade sector is about 17 percentage-points larger than for the San Gabriel Valley and about 24 percentage-points larger than that of Los Angeles County.
- Over the past 15 years, the City of Industry has added 1,349 new businesses.

Approximately 67,000 people are employed by businesses in the City of Industry.

209,000
jobs in Los Angeles County.

Economic Impact



In total, the City of Industry provides Los Angeles County with **\$19 billion of labor income** and **\$52 billion of sales**.

- Directly, the City of Industry provides \$11 billion of labor income, and over \$30 billion in sales in the Los Angeles region.
- Indirectly, the City of Industry supports an additional \$9 billion of labor income, and \$22 billion of sales in the Los Angeles region.



The total tax contribution of the City of Industry to Los Angeles County is **\$11.5 billion** which is almost evenly split between federal and state/local taxes.
