City of Industry Approves Grant to Support Non-Profit Helping Families and Children Struggling with Cancer
Grant to Megan's Wings will Support Children and Families Living with Cancer with Housing, Transportation Assistance and Other Vital Needs

City of Industry, CA – Last week, the Industry City Council approved a \$15,000 contribution to Megan's Wings. Megan's Wings is a nonprofit organization that works to positively impact the lives of children living with cancer by providing assistance and resources that are not traditionally covered by insurance. Megan's Wings provides temporary housing to parents to enable them to live close to the hospital where their child is receiving treatment and helps with transportation expenses that families incur while their child undergoes treatment.

In addition to housing and transportation assistance, the organization provides assistance for therapies not covered by insurance, prosthetics, grocery gift cards and more. Megan's Wings also helps provide funding and support for funeral expenses for the families of children without life insurance who lose their battle with cancer.

"As a mother who has gone through this excruciating and devastating experience, I know too well the hardships and expenses that come along at a time when families are already dealing with an insurmountable amount of emotional stress and pain," said Kim Savage, the President of Megan's Wings. "I started this non-profit in memory of my daughter to help families who are going through cancer treatments. We have been able to assist families throughout Southern California for years with the help of grants and donations and we are so grateful to the City of Industry for supporting and helping families in need."

The City Council approved the \$15,000 grant with a 4-0 vote on April 12, 2018. The City's donation serves a public purpose in that Megan's Wings has provided financial assistance to families that work in the City, as well as families throughout Los Angeles, Riverside and San Bernardino Counties.
