New Off-ramp to Open on the SR-60 ***Local Leaders will Gather to Watch a Truck Drive Through the Grand Opening Ribbon***

City of Industry, CA— On Wednesday, a new westbound off-ramp and a westbound auxiliary lane will open on the SR-60 to Grand Avenue. This new construction is part of the three-phased 57/60 Confluence Project.

The 57/60 Confluence Project will relieve one of the worst bottlenecks in the West Coast, which causes congestion for more than 356,000 motorists every day. This 57/60 Confluence Project is funded by a federal-state-local partnership. The City of Industry has contributed \$35 Million to the overall \$256 Million project.

It is estimated that phases I and II of the project alone will save truckers and commuters 725,000 hours per year.
